Transition to a <u>Free</u> All <u>Digital</u> Publication

Beginning with the January 2013 issue, The Epidemiology Monitor begins its formal transition to becoming a free access, all digital publication. Access to the online digital edition will be free of charge to all readers who subscribe by visiting <u>www.epimonitor.net/Subscribe.htm</u> and providing their email address. This change is in response to the opportunities afforded by new technologies and the changing reading habits of persons in the digital age.

The newsletter will appear online in the same familiar format subscribers are accustomed to, and they will be able to read through the publication on their computers or tablets in the same manner as they did with the print version. Over the next year, we will work to make the newsletter available on a wider range of mobile devices.

Readers with paid subscriptions that extend into 2013 will continue to receive a print version of the newsletter until their subscription expires. 
